WOKING ROTARY SWIMATHON 2021 (“THE EVENT”) TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BY COMPLETING AND SUBMITTING AN ENTRY FORM ENTRANTS AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Teams consist of up to six swimmers. No entrant may be under 8 years of age on the date of the event. Any entrant aged under 16 years at the date of their application must obtain the consent of their parent or guardian to enter the Event and their parent or guardian must sign the form overleaf to show their consent.

By completing and submitting a Team Entry form, the Entrants, or in the case of Entrants under 16 years of age their parents/guardians:

- accept that they have considered the risks involved in participating in the Event, and believe that the Entrant is healthy and fit to swim; and
- understand and accept that the Entrant participates at his/her own risk, and
- confirm that the Entrant can swim well enough to be safe in a 25 meter deep pool.

Entrants must adhere at all times to the rules and regulations of the Pool in the Park.

The Rotary Club of Woking shall not be liable for any indirect or consequential loss, damage, costs or expenses of any nature arising out of the Entrant's participation in the Event.

The Rotary Club of Woking shall also not be liable for the death, personal injury or other direct loss suffered by any Entrant which arises out of the Entrant's participation in the Event unless and to the extent only that it is directly caused by the negligence, wilful act or default of The Rotary Club of Woking.

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
